II. **New Business**

- Grant for outdoor classroom \$2000; will talk with staff about ideas
- Covid protocols continue, masking & sanitizing

Multi-Tier System

Tier 1 – specialist goes in to do a lesson with all students and they all benefit. EX: Teri in Crystals' room

Tier 2 – small group support by a specialist

Tier 3 – individual support

Sharing Balls Outside – questions about sharing balls outside...any feeling about this? We're thinking of allowing kids to play outside with basketball or football. It seems contact of surfaces is lessened since the start of the year. 2 people spoke up...one said people can tell their children to not participate if they don't want them to.

Lunch Take-Outs:
